Bogan Shire Council (in partnership with Coonamble Shire Council, Gilgandra Shire Council and Warren Shire Council)	Total Strategic Asset Management System for Rural Councils	400,000	The Project involves the implementation of a Total Strategic Asset Management System across four adjoining councils: Bogan, Coonamble, Gilgandra and Warren.
Bourke Shire Council	Integration of Software	75,000	The Project involves the implementation of new software package to allow a greater integration of systems across council operations.
Bourke Shire Council (in partnership with Brewarrina Shire Council and Walgett Shire Council)	Aboriginal Community Based Environmental and Waste Management	380,000	The Project involves the establishment of a waste aid model across five Aboriginal communities in Western NSW. The model consists of two parts: (i) Aboriginal community clean up and waste management infrastructure supply and (ii) establishing an Aboriginal Community-based Environmental Management (ACBEM) program.
Carrathool Shire Council	Review of Council Services Delivery	28,000	The Project involves a review of council services to identify efficiencies and possible savings in consultation with community and staff.

Hay Shire Council	Make Hay Connected Program	100,000	The Project progresses a key component of the Council's digital transformation improving connections, both within council and to the community.
Narrandera Shire Council	Lighting and Energy Efficiency Implementation	150,000	The Project involves the implementation of efficient energy strategies such as LED lighting with Council building and street lighting, PV Solar Energy for Council buildings and sewerage treatments and modifying existing engineering systems such as pump efficiency.
Narrandera Shire Council (in partnership with Leeton Shire Council)	Enhanced Shared Services /Joint Service Delivery	40,000	The Project progresses a number of key projects focused on enhancing shared services and joint service delivery across the two councils.
Narromine Shire Council	Implementation of a New Enterprise Planning and Resource Application	75,000	The Project involves the implementation of business management software consisting of a suite of integrated applications to better support the way council conducts its business.
Temora Shire Council	Virtualisation of Servers – Upgrade of Information Technology Capability	80,750	The Project involves the implementation of virtual services and upgrade of IT capability.
Tenterfield Shire Council	Capacity Building Project	140,000	The Project involves a review of council operations with a focus on organisational and capacity development including staff development and training, continuous improvement, business efficiencies and audit of works practices.
